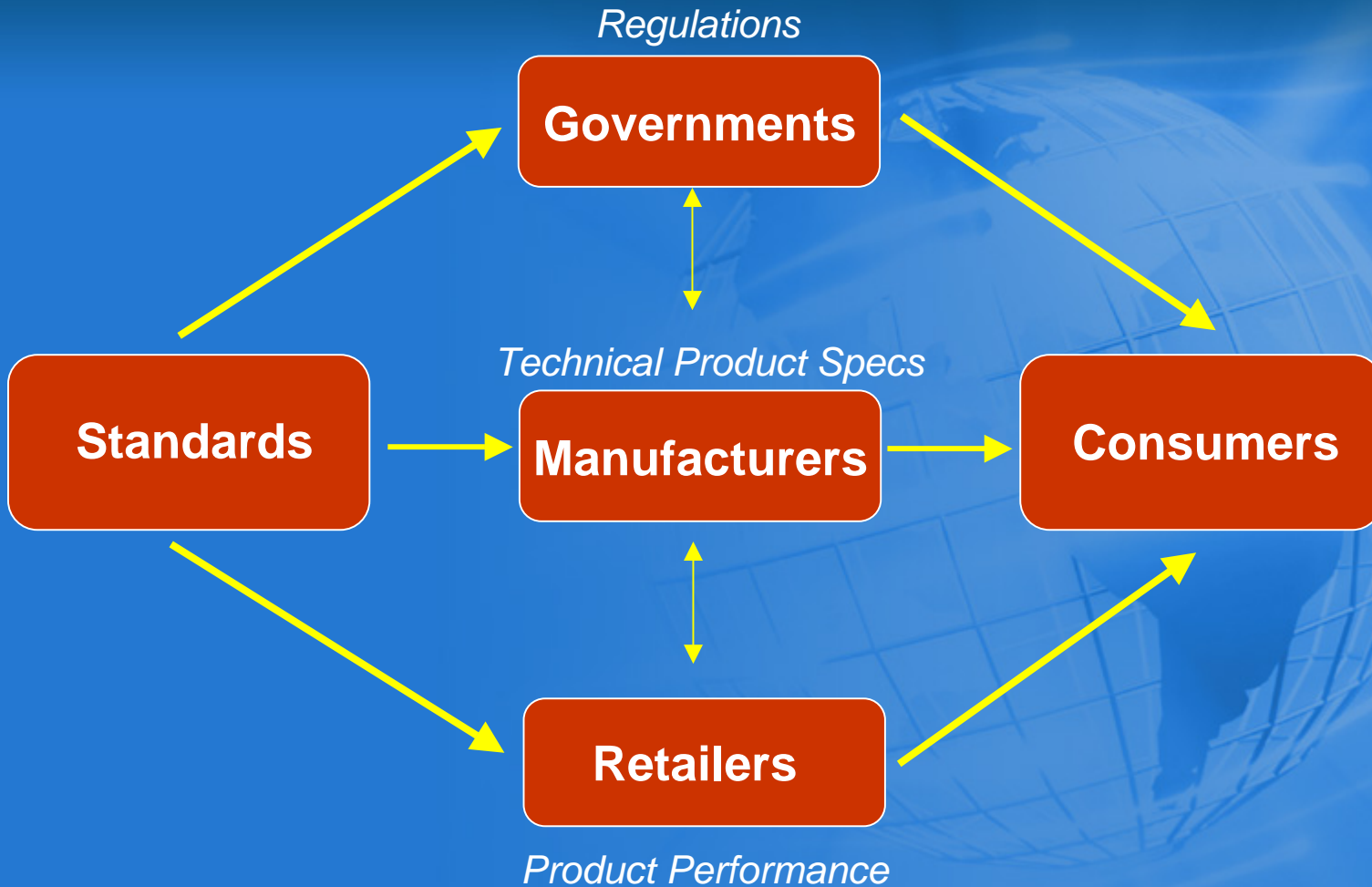

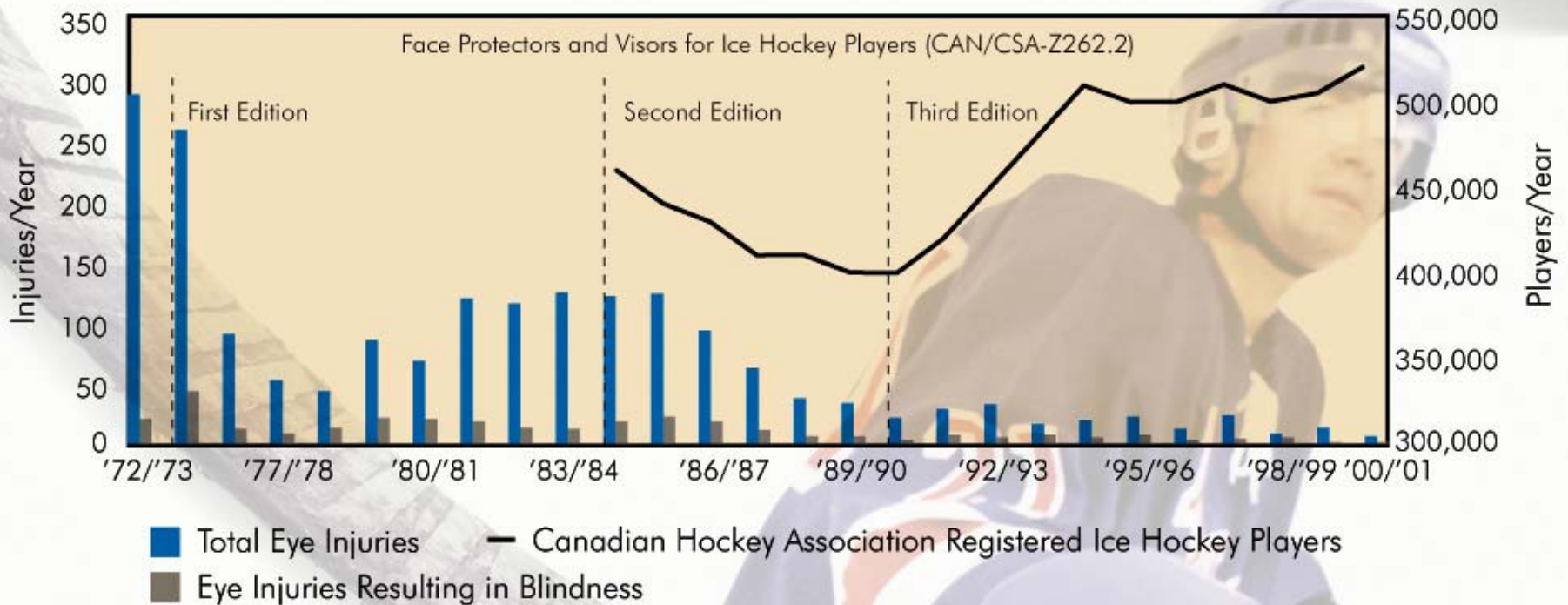

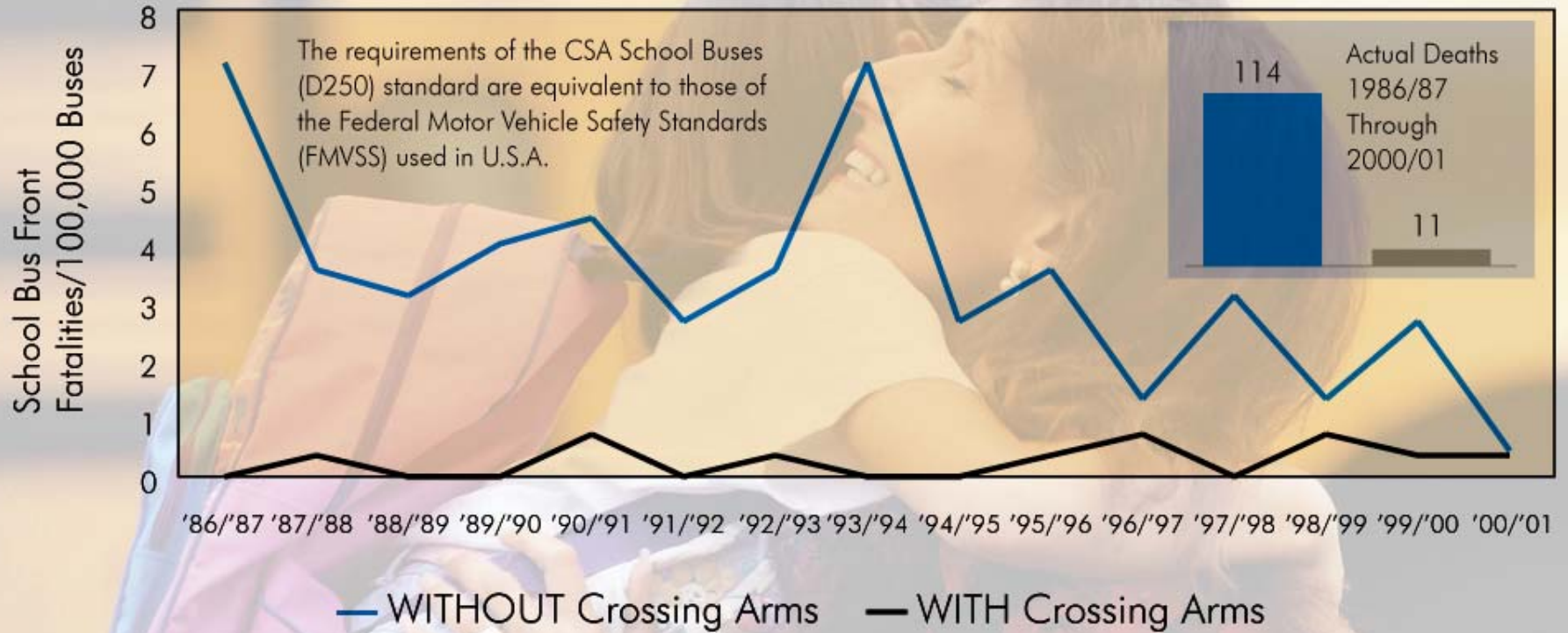

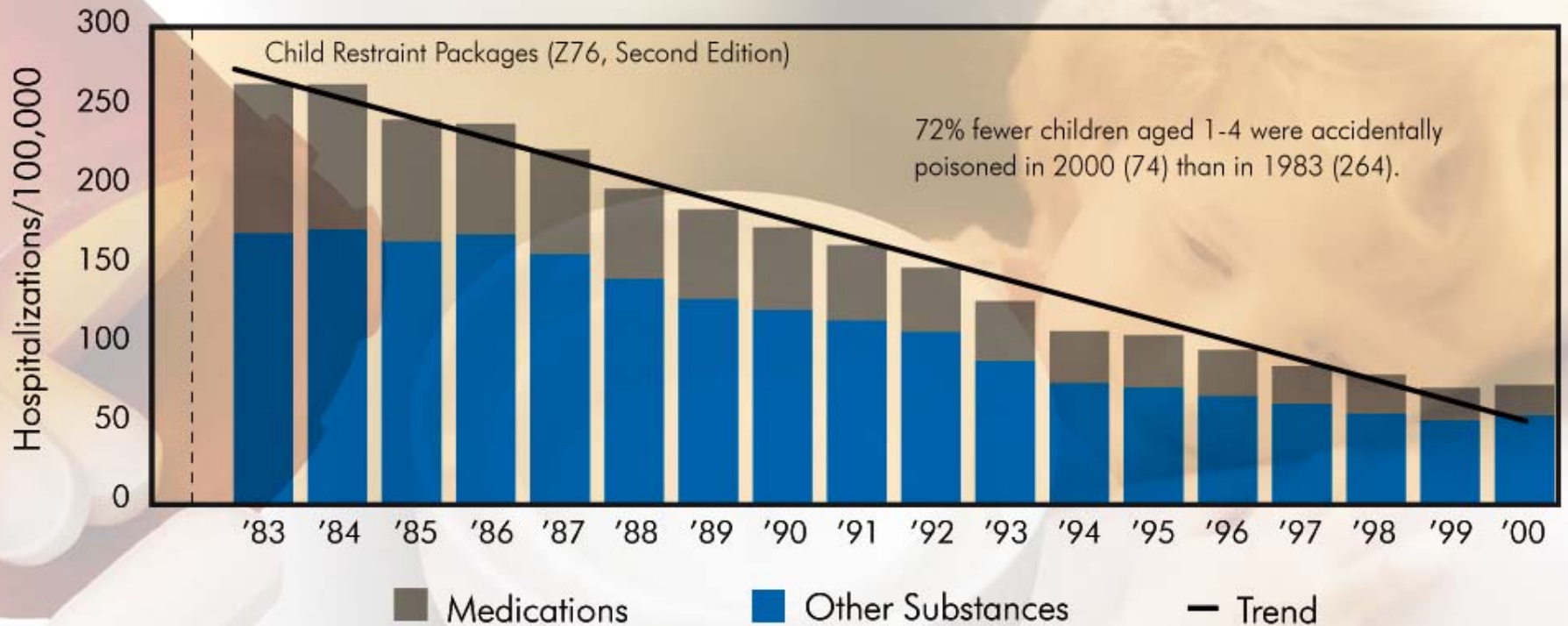
Fatalities in Front of School Buses With or Without Crossing Arms in U.S.A.
