What is an ATV?

- A vehicle with
 - four low-pressure tires
 - a seat straddled by an operator
 - handlebars for steering control
- Youth ATVs, Adult ATVs
- Single-Rider, Tandem

CPSC and ATVs: History

1980s

- 1985 – ANPR
- 1987 – CPSC lawsuit against industry
- 1988 – Consent Decrees established

CPSC and ATVs: History

1990s and 2000s

- 1990 - Voluntary Standard published
- 1998 - Consent Decrees expire
- 1998 - Voluntary Action Plans
- 2002 - Petition filed with CPSC
- 2003 - Field Hearings
- 2005 - Briefing on Petition
